Importance and spiritual significance




While these apparitions have not been officially confirmed by the Catholic Church, they have profoundly impacted individuals and communities worldwide. Pilgrims visit Medjugorje to deepen their faith and experience spiritual renewal. Many describe feelings of tranquillity and inspiration upon arrival, making the village a beacon of hope for those navigating life's challenges. The emphasis on prayer, confession, and reflection aligns with the goals of spiritual enrichment for visitors of diverse backgrounds.

Main Churches and Religious Sites

Medjugorje's spiritual heart is St. James Church, dedicated to St. James the Apostle, the patron saint of pilgrims. Located in the centre of the village, this Catholic church serves as the gathering point for pilgrims and hosts daily Masses, confessions, and other religious services. Its spacious grounds include an outdoor altar, a statue of the Virgin Mary, and areas for private prayer.

Other significant sites include:

- Apparition Hill (Podbrdo): The site of the reported Marian apparitions, marked by a statue of the Virgin Mary. Pilgrims often ascend this hill in prayer, reflecting on the messages of peace delivered here.
- Mount Križevac (Cross Mountain): A towering hill with a large cross at its summit, serving as a symbol of faith and sacrifice. Pilgrims hike to the top as an act of devotion, often praying the Stations of the Cross along the way.
- Cenacolo Community: A center for prayer and spiritual healing that supports individuals struggling with addiction and other challenges. The community welcomes pilgrims seeking renewal and guidance.

The Vatican's position on Medjugorje

Since the reported Marian apparitions in 1981, Medjugorje has drawn significant attention within the Catholic Church. While the Vatican has not officially confirmed the supernatural nature of these events, it recognizes the profound spiritual impact the site has had on pilgrims worldwide.

In 2024, Pope Francis granted approval for official pilgrimages to Medjugorje, allowing dioceses and parishes to organize visits. This decision highlights the Church's acknowledgment of the deep faith and devotion that many pilgrims experience while visiting. The Vatican has emphasized that this approval does not validate the alleged Marian apparitions but instead focuses on the positive spiritual fruits that Medjugorje has produced, including conversions, religious vocations, and renewed commitment to faith. Pilgrims visiting Medjugorje engage in prayer, Eucharistic Adoration, confession, and contemplation. Many describe a sense of peace and spiritual renewal upon arrival, reinforcing its role as a place of profound faith. The Church encourages believers to approach Medjugorje as a destination for encountering Christ through personal reflection, prayer, and participation in religious practices rather than focusing solely on the apparitions.

The Vatican continues to monitor and evaluate the phenomenon surrounding Medjugorje. In 2021, Pope Francis appointed Archbishop Aldo Cavalli as the Apostolic Visitor, responsible for pastoral care and overseeing the spiritual well-being of pilgrims. His role reflects the Vatican's commitment to ensuring that Medjugorje remains a place of genuine devotion and spiritual growth.

While the Church maintains a discerning stance, Medjugorje has undeniably become a significant center for pilgrimage, offering visitors an opportunity to deepen their faith. The Vatican's approach balances careful evaluation with recognition of the site's spiritual importance, allowing believers to embrace Medjugorje as a place of prayer, conversion, and peace.



The Visionaries of Medjugorje: A story of Faith & Revelation

The Beginning: June 24, 1981

It was an ordinary summer day when **Ivanka Ivanković-Elez** (born June 21, 1966) and **Mirjana Dragičević-Soldo** (born March 18, 1965), two teenagers from the village, decided to take a walk near Mount Podbrdo, later known as Apparition Hill. As they approached the hill, Ivanka, who had recently lost her mother, suddenly saw a luminous figure of a woman holding a child. She immediately told Mirjana, who also saw the figure but expressed uncertainty about what they were witnessing. Although they felt drawn to the radiant figure, they hesitated and fled in fear.

Later that evening, Ivanka and Mirjana recounted the incident to their families, describing the woman as beautiful and surrounded by a radiant light. Despite initial scepticism from the villagers, curiosity grew as the girls shared their experience with conviction.

The Group of Six: June 25, 1981

The following day, June 25, marked a turning point. Four other young villagers—**Vicka Ivanković-Mijatović** (born September 3, 1964), **Ivan Dragičević** (born May 25, 1965), **Marija Pavlović-Lunetti** (born April 1, 1965), and **Jakov Čolo** (born March 6, 1971)—joined Ivanka and Mirjana, intrigued by their story. Together, they climbed Apparition Hill, where they once again encountered the luminous woman, who identified herself as the “Queen of Peace”. This time, the visionaries felt no fear. Instead, they experienced a deep sense of peace, joy, and love emanating from her presence.

During this encounter, the Virgin Mary reportedly conveyed messages emphasizing peace and reconciliation, urging humanity to turn back to God. She encouraged prayer, fasting, faith, and conversion as the keys to spiritual renewal.

The Visionaries of Medjugorje: A story of Faith & Revelation

The Apparitions continue: The Ten Secrets

Since 1981, six visionaries have reported regular apparitions of the Virgin Mary, during which she delivered messages of peace, prayer, and spiritual renewal. Over time, she entrusted them with ten prophetic secrets concerning the future of humanity, the Church, and the world. Though undisclosed, these secrets reportedly contain warnings and divine interventions aimed at guiding people back to faith.

Mirjana Dragičević-Soldo has been designated to reveal the secrets at the appropriate time. Ten days before each event, she will inform a chosen priest, who will announce it publicly three days prior. One key revelation—the Third Secret—is said to involve a permanent, miraculous sign appearing on Apparition Hill, confirming the authenticity of the apparitions.

While some secrets foretell significant global changes, their purpose is not fear but spiritual renewal, calling humanity to prayer, conversion, and reconciliation. The visionaries emphasize that time for transformation is limited, urging people to embrace faith and prepare spiritually for what lies ahead.

The Messages

The core of the Virgin Mary's messages revolves around five key themes:

1. **Peace:** Mary described herself as the “Queen of Peace”, emphasizing the need for reconciliation among individuals and nations.
2. **Prayer:** She called for dedicated prayer, especially the daily recitation of the rosary.
3. **Faith:** Mary urged people to strengthen their faith in God and live lives centred on Christ.
4. **Fasting:** She recommended fasting as a spiritual discipline to combat sin and purify the soul.
5. **Conversion:** Mary emphasized repentance and a complete spiritual transformation, calling humanity to turn away from sin and embrace lives of love and devotion.

Through her messages, the Virgin Mary sought to guide humanity toward hope and salvation. She encouraged individuals to trust in God's love and live in harmony with His will. Meeting the visionaries offers pilgrims an unparalleled opportunity to hear firsthand accounts of the apparitions and gain deeper insights into the Virgin Mary's messages. Along the pathway, visitors encounter prayer stations featuring bronze reliefs of the mysteries of the rosary, which guide them in meditation and prayer.

The climb requires both physical effort and spiritual devotion, as the rocky terrain serves as a reminder of the challenges faced during one's faith journey. Despite the steep paths, the hill's accessibility ensures that pilgrims of all ages can make the ascent, albeit with care. Many describe the experience as humbling and profoundly moving.

Height & Perspective

Apparition Hill rises approximately 500 meters (1,640 feet) above sea level, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding countryside. From the summit, visitors can admire the peaceful village of Medjugorje nestled among vineyards and hills. The panoramic vista serves as a reminder of the beauty and serenity that define this sacred place.

The statue of the Virgin Mary, which marks the site of the apparitions, stands as a beacon of hope and devotion at the top of the hill. Pilgrims often pause here to pray, reflect, and connect with the divine presence symbolized by the statue.

Cross Mountain: A symbol of Devotion & Sacrifice

Historical & Spiritual Symbolism

The origins of Cross Mountain date back to 1934, when the villagers of Medjugorje chose to erect a monumental concrete cross on the summit to commemorate the 1900th anniversary of Jesus Christ's crucifixion. This act was a testament to their deep faith and gratitude for Christ's sacrifice, which redeemed humanity and offered salvation. It was also a communal expression of love, hope, and unity during a time of spiritual growth and challenge.

The cross itself is inscribed with the words: "To Jesus Christ, Redeemer of the human race, as a sign of their faith, love, and hope." These words reflect the villagers' acknowledgment of Christ's central role in their lives and their commitment to living in harmony with His teachings. It is said that the relic of the True Cross was embedded into this structure, further sanctifying it as a place of devotion.



Terrain & Pathway

Cross Mountain's terrain is rugged and steep, requiring effort and devotion from those who choose to make the pilgrimage. The pathway leading to the summit winds through rocky slopes and uneven ground, creating an authentic and humbling experience. Along the trail, pilgrims encounter bronze reliefs depicting the Stations of the Cross, which serve as meditative points for prayer and reflection.

The hike up Cross Mountain is not only physically demanding but also spiritually enriching. Pilgrims often carry their personal intentions, burdens, and prayers, offering them to God as they ascend. The rugged landscape mirrors the challenges faced in life, reminding visitors of the importance of perseverance and faith in overcoming obstacles.

Height & Panaroma

Cross Mountain rises approximately 520 meters (1,700 feet) above sea level, making it a commanding presence in Medjugorje. From the summit, visitors are greeted with breathtaking views of the surrounding Herzegovinian countryside. The sight of the village, vineyards, and hills from above evokes a sense of peace and serenity, allowing pilgrims to feel connected to both God's creation and their spiritual journey.

The concrete cross at the summit stands 8.5 meters (28 feet) tall, serving as a powerful reminder of Christ's ultimate sacrifice. Pilgrims often gather here to pray, reflect, and leave their intentions at the foot of the cross, making the summit a deeply sacred space.

History of St. James Church

The history of St. James Church dates back to the late 19th century. The original parish church was completed in 1897, five years after the founding of the parish by Bishop Paškal Buconjić. However, the structure was built on unstable foundations, leading to cracks and eventual deterioration. After World War I, the parishioners initiated plans to construct a new church to better serve the growing community.

The current St. James Church was designed by Zagreb-based architect Stjepan Podhorsky. Construction began in 1934 and was completed on January 19, 1969, when the church was consecrated. Despite its completion, additional work continued on the interior and bell towers until 1980. The church's classical basilical style, with its twin towers and three-door entrance, reflects a timeless architectural elegance.

Since the apparitions of 1981, St. James Church has undergone further renovations to accommodate the increasing number of pilgrims. In 1989, an outdoor altar and seating area were added to host large gatherings, solidifying the church's role as a pilgrimage hub.

St. James Church has been blessed with the service of many dedicated priests who have contributed to its spiritual mission. Among them are:



In 1990, the icon was located in the Sanctuary of Divine Mercy in Trento, Italy, where it became associated with the miraculous healing of Ugo Festa, a man suffering from multiple sclerosis, epilepsy, and spinal deformities. After praying before the icon for three days, Ugo experienced an extraordinary healing, which was later recognized as one of the proofs for the beatification of St. Faustina.

At the request of the Archbishop of Split, the icon was transferred to Medjugorje and eventually placed in the Surmanci chapel. Since then, the chapel has become a pilgrimage destination for those seeking healing and spiritual renewal. The miraculous events associated with the icon continue to inspire faith and devotion among visitors.

The miraculous icon of Jesus of Mercy is at the center of the chapel's spiritual importance. Pilgrims recount experiences of healing and divine intervention upon praying before the icon. Medjugorje, already a global pilgrimage site, provided the ideal setting for a Cenacolo community due to its deeply spiritual character and the messages of the Virgin Mary. The integration of Cenacolo into the fabric of Medjugorje further emphasized the village’s role as a place of transformation and hope.
